Pathways of Central Ohio offers 24-hour, 7-day-a-week telephone crisis services for issues involving mental health, suicide, alcohol and drug use/abuse and intellectual disabilities.

Information and referral services include assistance in linking callers with resources such as temporary housing, financial help, medical care, counseling, victim assistance, domestic violence resources, suicide prevention and resources for senior citizens. Pathways is also the main point of contact for community emergencies or disasters, sponsors a recovery line for persons recovering from mental illness and provides after-hours coverage for many Licking and Knox county social service agencies.
